Therefore, we have created a program that **pays you** to help spread the word and get new racers to become IHRA members. It really doesn't require much work from you, just being a cheerleader for the best sanctioning body in the World!

HERE IS HOW IT WORKS

Get racers to sign up as new IHRA members from January 1, 2020 – September 30, 2020 and we pay you as follows:

IHRA SILVER track status	Sign up 15 or more New Members	Annual Reward - \$200
IHRA GOLD track status	Sign up 25 or more New Members	Annual Reward - \$450
IHRA PLATINUM track status	Sign up 40 or more New Members	Annual Reward - \$1000

Disclaimers:

- New members are defined as a person who has not had an IHRA membership in the past 36 months.
- Must be a full membership (not an associate).
- All reward payments will be processed and sent by December 31, 2020.
- Tracks are credited for each new membership based on the applicant's claim as their home track.
- In addition to the monetary reward, tracks achieving SILVER, GOLD or PLATINUM status will also be provided with a digital website graphic for your website indicating you are a SILVER, GOLD or PLATINUM status IHRA track.

To All Track Operators:

For 2020, we are continuing the popular IHRA online membership and license program in addition to offering the paper forms. The online applications and renewal forms are available through the IHRA website under the membership tab. NOTE – all online applications and renewals receive a \$10 discount on their membership and license fees.

The 2020 IHRA membership forms are as follows:

1. **Membership & License Form** – the paper application for anyone who would like a membership and license with IHRA. The bottom of the second page (Competition License Form) will need to be filled out if a racer is quicker than 10.0 seconds in the quarter mile or 6.50 in the eighth mile. We also require a copy of a valid state driver's license, over and above a learner's permit. If an NHRA transfer, passes are not required, but we do require a copy of the applicant's NHRA license.
2. **Licensing Passes form** – required for online applications for any license quicker than 10.0 in the quarter mile or 6.50 in the eighth mile. Once filled out and signed by the track, the applicant can scan and submit this form with their online application.
3. **Physical form**
4. **Junior Dragster License Form** – For any Junior racer. A copy of the racer's birth certificate is required along with passes being made and approved by a track official for whichever junior dragster class the racer would be eligible for. If a Junior wants to upgrade from Advanced to Masters class, they will need to make licensing passes quicker than 8.90 but no faster than 7.90.
5. **Teen Championship Racing (TCR) membership and license application** – to be filled out by any teen who does not yet have their valid state driver's license and would like to experience the thrill of drag racing in a full-sized car. A copy of the birth certificate is required with this form, along with all testing completed and approved by a track official.
